

Cameron Lions Club High School Senior Scholarship Guidelines

To be considered for the Cameron Lions Club Scholarship, the following guidelines apply:

- Actual place of residence must be within Cameron Parish (using someone else's address is strictly prohibited and will result in revocation, in the event a scholarship is awarded)
- Cameron Parish residents attending public, private, parochial or BESE-approved home study schools are eligible to apply
- Applicant must be a member of the graduating class of this current year and currently maintaining a minimum of a cumulative 3.0 grade point average
- Applicant must enroll in a post-secondary institution
- The application must be completed in its entirety and submitted timely to be received no later than May 1, 2018, to the following mailing address:

- Applications shall not be submitted in person
- In addition to the application, the following official documents must be attached:
 1. *A listing of school and community activities of the past four years, including offices held, and awards and honors achieved*
 2. *An official, stamped copy of current transcript, including current rank in class*
 3. *A complete copy of highest ACT scores earned*
 4. *The signed copy of the application form, including financial information on both parents, regardless of current marital status*
 5. *A computer-generated original essay of 3 or more paragraphs, addressing the following topic, "What are my hopes and dreams for Cameron Parish?"*
- If selected as a scholarship recipient, proof of enrollment and fee invoice, mailed to the official Lions Club address above, will be required for the initial payment.
- If the scholarship awards subsequent payments, recipient must maintain the status of a full-time student, per the institution's official definition, and must maintain a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average. It is the responsibility of the recipient to mail the official grades for the previous semester and proof of payment for the upcoming semester to the Lions Club official address above, before the start of the next semester.
- If the scholarship awards subsequent payments, consecutive semesters are required. Any break in consecutive attendance will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
- All checks will be written to both the recipient and the educational institution.
